



## **Cleanser for Tubs, Sinks and Glass Shower Doors**

1/4 cup baking soda

Lemon juice ( fresh or bottled )

A few drops of unscented liquid castile soap

2 drops lemon essential oil

2 drops grapefruit essential oil

2 drops geranium or rosemary essential oil

Put the baking soda in a glass container.

Add lemon juice to make a thin, watery paste. (When you add the lemon juice to the baking soda it will foam and bubble ).

Add liquid soap, the essential oils and stir.

If the mixture thickens before you've finished it up you can add either a bit of water or more lemon juice.

I usually scour my surfaces with a very soft scotch guard pad ( Be CAUTIUOS when using these as damage may occur if used on surfaces that are made from vinyl. ) It is advisable to do a small test spot first in an inconspicuous area. Rinse well.

This leaves your bathroom sinks and tub sparkling and the fragrance will linger for some time leaving your whole bathroom smelling fresh. It can be fun to experiment with different oils and change the number of drops used to create your own special blends.
